# SCAFFOLD SAFETY

## Mobile Scaffold

Is the scaffold safe?  
What to look out for:

Guardrail at 1 metre and mid rail at 0.5 metre above deck on all sides

Platform hatches/trap doors should be closed

Toeboards are in place on all sides

Ladder must be secured

Bracing installed

Foundation firm and level

Wheels have breaks which are locked

Scaffold tag needs to be in place and signed off weekly by the contractor who erected the scaffold

Exclusion zones are required if scaffold is installed for up to 24 hours. Cones and retractable bars or folding fences are sufficient, if the scaffold is under supervision.

If the scaffold is going to be left unattended overnight or be in use for more than 24 hours, access to the scaffold must be restricted. Access must be restricted by using a solid fence or retracting the scaffold ladder.
